of giving a tour to our founder and reconnecting with him on the origin of ICSK. Gary Taylor was a CMU grad student in 1990 when he started the Isabella Community Soup Kitchen. What was originally just an idea for a capstone project, quickly became a real

physical place with a mission to serve those in need. Gary was inspired to start ICSK when he witnessed a peer eating a ketchup sandwich. After conducting a needs assessment survey, Gary saw that there was a real food insecurity problem here in Isabella County – from there, the Isabella Community Soup Kitchen was born. After our founding in 1990, and operating out of church basements for several years, in 2002 we found our permanent home on Adams Street in Mt. Pleasant, where we remain to this day.
